

That outreach gave Bill a new view on how he would use his talent to help those less fortunate. As The Honor Card program continues to grow, Bill employs his artistic gifts, generating resources needed to help solve community problems and meet area needs. In its 30th year the Honor Card is utilized in fourteen cities and has raised nearly \$7 million.
